You will then receive a link to the online meeting which will be sent to you a day before the meeting.

## School Uniform

We would like to thank parents/carers who have ensured that children are coming to school dressed in their full school uniform each day. However, there are some children who are not wearing the correct school uniform, including PE kits.

Children in Reception should wear a white polo shirt. Children in Y1—Y6 must wear a white collared school shirt and tie. Ties can be purchased from school using ParentPay. Please contact the school office if you wish to purchase one.

If you need to order school uniform online from the Uniform Specialists, you may wish to tick the 'Deliver to my school' box for free delivery.

**PE Kits** should be worn to school on the days that your child has PE (Y1-Y6). Please ensure that they are wearing their correct colour PE t-shirt with either navy or black jogging bottoms. **Trainers should be plain black or your child can wear black plimsolls.**

As the weather changes, children should be wearing coats or jackets to school. Please make sure your child has one each day.

All items of school uniform, including coats and jackets should have your child's name clearly marked. It is difficult to retrieve lost items, if you do not put names on school uniform.

## Covid-19 Guidance for Parents

### School Photographs

On Friday 23rd October, Braiswick Photographic will be in school to take individual photos of children.

Sibling photographs will be moved forward to a date next year.

Please ensure your child is in full school uniform.

### Additional Homework Book Orders

If you wish to order the Collins or CGP books for your child, years Reception to Y6, please visit ParentPay and make payment by **Friday 16th October**. We will not be able to accept any orders after this date.

If you need to activate your ParentPay account please contact the school office.

### Nasal Flu Vaccinations

The school immunisation team will be in school to deliver the nasal flu vaccine for children from Reception to Y6, on Wednesday 25th November.

Parents will receive a consent form nearer the time.

If your child or a member of your household develops any of the following symptoms, please ensure that they are tested for Covid-19. These include;

- High temperature of over 37.8
- New continuous cough
- Loss of or change in taste or smell

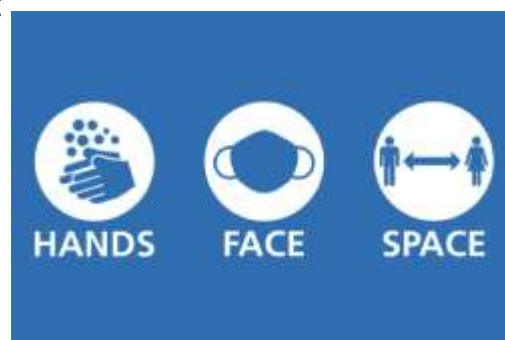
If your child has a runny nose, sore throat or is sneezing, without any of the above symptoms, they can still attend school, if well enough.

If your child or a member of your household needs to get tested for Covid-19, there are testing sites locally;

- Featherstone Terrace Car Park, Southall
- Michael Flanders Centre, Acton
- Mobile testing unit every 3 days at Gurnell Leisure Centre and Heathrow Airport
